## *Virtual Colonoscopy Bowel Preparation Office Instructions*

If your patient is scheduled to have a Virtual Colonoscopy at Radiology Associates of Hartford, PC (RAH), please make sure the patient has the following “Bowel Prep Kit” at least three (3) days prior to their scheduled examination:

- **Tagitol V**
- **One (1) bottle of Redicat**
- **A prescription (Rx) for “TriLyte”**
- **Patient Prep instructions titled: Virtual Colonoscopy Bowel Preparation**

The Virtual Colonoscopy studies are conducted in the mornings. Bowel movements should be clear, with yellow and/or green material on the morning of the study. There should be no brown stool present on the morning of their scheduled exam.

In rare cases, the initial bowel prep will fail. A sign that the initial bowel prep has failed will be that on the morning of the study, the patient’s bowel movements will contain brown stool. In this case, the patient should be instructed to call Radiology Associates of Hartford, PC and re-schedule their appointment to the following day.

Patients will have to obtain another “Bowel Prep Kit” from Radiology Associates of Hartford, PC or their ordering physician.

Virtual Colonoscopy studies can be scheduled at Radiology Associates of Hartford, PC Monday through Thursday.

Immediately following the Virtual Colonoscopy study, patients can resume their normal diet, medications and daily activity.
